

Comstock Cemetery

The Comstock cemetery is located in Comstock, Val Verde county, Texas, on the western edge of Comstock between US Highway 90 and the Union Pacific railroad tracks. The cemetery was inventoried by the Val Verde County Genealogy Society on April 14, 2003. Some inscriptions were very difficult to read and many had no markers at all, therefore there are many burials besides the burials listed, and it is quite possible some errors have been made.
